

Torn Paper

1. Tear brown builder's paper into random pieces. Wrinkle slightly if you choose to.
2. Apply a layer of VINYL TO VINYL glue to the wall with a heavy nap roller.
3. Dunk the paper into a bucket of water, shake off the excess water, then press paper to the wall over the glue covered area.
4. Using a trowel, press the paper smoothly to the wall. Spread excess glue on the preceding pieces, just make sure there are no "blobs" of glue anywhere.
5. Repeat steps 2-4, applying pieces randomly, overlapping edges, until entire wall is covered. Be sure to use pieces with straight edges along trim work.
6. Let dry 24 hours.
7. Seal with poly acrylic or paint with satin sheen latex paint.
8. Apply glaze color of your choice!
